

Temporary Protective Order / Interim Order:

Mon-Friday 8:30-4:00pm. Go to the District or Circuit Court, ask the Civil Clerk's desk for Petition of Protection. (If in Circuit Court, see POARP below). After business hours, weekends, and holidays go to the Court Commissioners to get an Interim Order. The Commissioner will inform you of the date/time of your second hearing.
